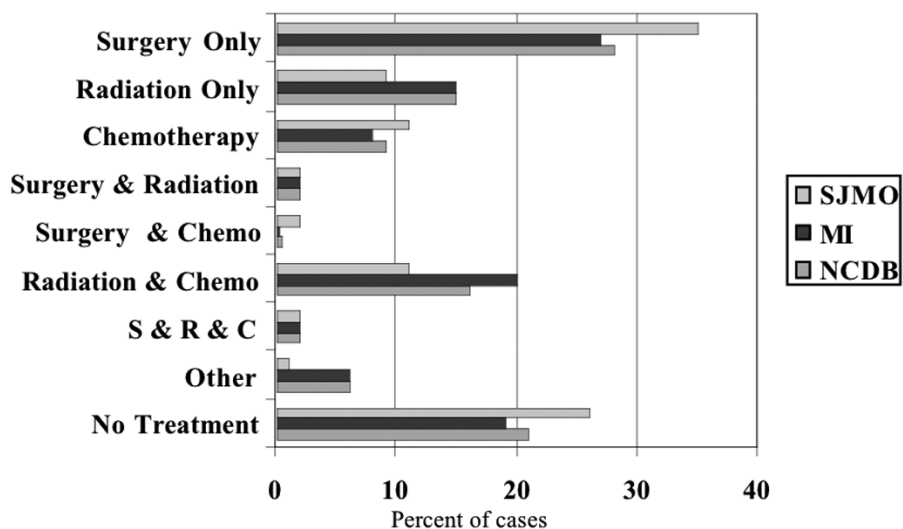


# SITE REPORT – LUNG CANCER

## Reported Lung Cancer by First Course Treatment

In general, the primary treatment for NSCL cancer is surgery for stages I and II, chemotherapy for stage IV and multiple modality treatment for stage III. The first course of treatment analysis shows that, compared to national and state percentages, there was more surgery only treatment, less radiotherapy with and without chemotherapy and more no-treatment cases. This occurred although the stage distribution is not very different from the comparison population. This raises the question as to whether, after diagnosis, a significant number of patients received their non-surgical treatment elsewhere.

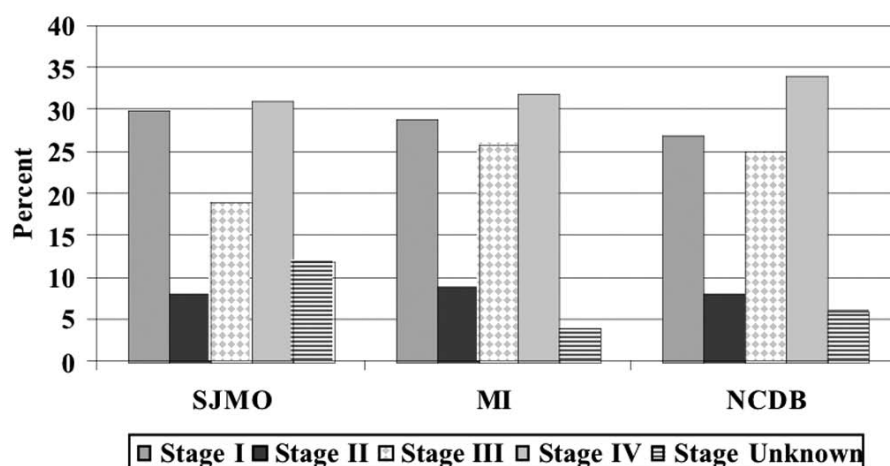

## Lung Stage Grouping

The stage distribution of NSCL cancer is also similar to distributions in the national and state population, except that over ten percent of the cases were of unknown stage in our population, as compared to near five percent in the national and state figures.
